

5th Delta Police High School Golf Tournament April 20-21, 2009

Temperatures plummeted with a clear night. All players were excited to get started and it showed in the scores. Although the temperature stayed cool the golf was hot. Earl Marriott shot a sizzling 296 to take the team low gross, led by grade 9 Adam Svennson's 2 under 70, Earl Marriott would finish with a two day total of 600. Sardis had a good second day to pass Elgin Park for second place. Unfortunately for Adam, he couldn't hold off the strong and consistent play of Alex Michalowski who shot an even par 72 to win the individual low gross by one stroke over Svennson. Yohann Vora of Seaquam in Delta had the low round of the day with a 3 under 69. This score vaulted Vora into third place.
