



HIGH SCHOOL GOLF TOURNAMENT

7th Delta Police High School Golf Tournament April 18-19, 2011

Players were greeted with great weather for the first day of the tournament at Kings Links. Temperatures in the low teens and little wind created excellent scoring conditions. After the first round Adam Svennson from Earl Marriott carded a four under 68. He was followed closely by Matt Dorian of Elgin Park at 3 under 69. Earl Marriott led all teams at the end of Day 1 after shooting a team total 309. Brookwood, from Langley, was only 3 shots behind at 312 and St. Georges was in third place after carding a team total 318. Approximately 45 minutes after the start of the second day, at Northview's Ridge course, an unbelievable storm system came blazing through Cloverdale and Northview. Fork Lightning, very cold temperatures and a massive hail storm put a halt to the tournament for an hour. Everyone had to take cover. Once play resumed, Adam Svennson kept up his excellent play and finished Day 2 with another 4 under par 68. His final totals were 68-68-136. His impressive play allowed him to win by 7 strokes over Matt Dorian 69-74-143. Third place was taken by Gleneagle's David Lee 74-70-144. Earl Marriott three-peated as team champions with a 309-311-620 total team score. Brookwood took second place honours 312-315-627 and St. Georges placed third 318-320-638. James Bobyn from Immaculata was this year's scholarship winner.
