

8th Delta Police High School Golf Tournament April 16-17, 2012

Fewer players than normal for the tournament this year as teachers were forced to put sports on hold due to a labour disruption. The early morning started out with a lot of wind and rain, however, thankfully the 8th Delta Police High School Golf Tournament didn't tee off till 1:00 pm. The clouds broke and the weather changed. Cloudy periods with sun and temperatures in the low teens greeted golfers. However, the wind was blowing hard in true Kings Links style. Day 1 scores rose with the ever increasing wind velocity, however, Sean Gill from West Point Grey Academy tamed the howling winds to shoot even par 72, a fantastic score under very difficult conditions. David Lee and Henry Lee from Gleneagle in Coquitlam were tied for second with two over 74's. Earl Marriott 1 finished the day in first place with a team total of 325, followed closely by Gleneagle at 326 and St. Georges in 3rd at 337. The second day of the tournament at the Ridge course at Northview produced some very good scores. Temperatures started in low single digits but increased nicely throughout the day. The course was in magnificent condition and players enjoyed their time with the Delta Police Members. Sean Gill continued his stellar play finishing in the lead 72-71-143. David Lee 74-73-147 placed second and Henry Lee 74-74-148 placed third. For the fourth year in a row, Earl Marriott took the team honours 325-298-623 outpacing Gleneagle in second place by 17 strokes. No scholarship applications were forwarded to the committee this year so the award was not presented.
